Restructuring of Finance and Accounts Department of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDA) and Approved Formats of Books of Accounts/Other Accounting Records in line with IPSAS Accrual Basis of Accounting

As part of the ongoing transformation of the Treasury services for greater efficiency, transparency and accountability as enshrined in the Economic Reforms and Governance Project (ERGP), the drive to enhance and sustain the robust achievements in the Public Finance Management Reforms, the Head of the Civil Service of the Federation has approved the restructuring of the Finance and Accounts Department in MDA. Furthermore, the restructuring is to ensure standardization and uniformity in the discharge of the finance function in respect of

budgeting, accounting and financial reporting across MDA in line with the implementation of International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) Accrual Basis of Accounting.

2. Approved Organogram

Henceforth, the Finance and Accounts Department of MDA shall

have the following Divisions and Branches:

Approved Formats of Books of Accounts/Other Accounting Records

To meet the requirements of IPSAS Accrual Basis of Accounting, the Treasury has developed formats of Books of Accounts/Other Accounting Records for use by all MDA as Manual records in addition to the Federal Government Budgeting and Accounting Software, Government Integrated Financial Management Information System (GIFMIS) and other approved Platforms.
